The NSW government has a plan to open up the economy in stages. In the initial stages fully vaccinated people have reduced restrictions (also known as "more freedoms").

Non-essential businesses will be able to open up if they check the vaccination status of all those wishing to enter. This does NOT apply to essential businesses.

The Wingello Village Store and LPO is an essential business in multiple areas:

- Newspapers
- Fuel
- Great Food & Coffee (Take-away only)

As we have always done over the last twelve and a half years, we will continue to provide assistance to all who visit the store. We have never practised discrimination based on any physical, religious, medical or other grounds and do not intend to start now.

Dining in will only be available when all can dine in.

Our common Australian heritage has prized our commitment to treating everyone equally. It does not matter if the other person is rich or poor, from North, South, East or West, black or white, sick or well. We have always aimed at treating everyone with respect.

Even the rivalry between Sydney and Melbourne or differing football teams or codes has been more friendly rivalry than discriminatory.
