# Casburn Park Upgrade should be ready in June

*Looking like we can play in the park on the June Long weekend, 8 June!*

The Casburn Park upgrades continue to push ahead. The work is planned to complete ready for the long weekend in June, Saturday 8th. There will be an official grand opening on Friday 28 June when various VIPs and those involved with the funding and planning will be special guests.

Meanwhile, the Wingello Village Association has planned a sausage sizzle on Saturday 8th June from 10am. If the rain ends up causing a delay, this may be postponed to the following Saturday, but the construction team are very confident the upgrade is on track.

The car park surface and roadworks should happen in week starting 6 May. Over 3,000 plants will be put into the landscaping towards the end of the month.

Once all the fixed paths and boundaries are installed, lots of landscaping work will be done across the whole park.

So it will be a busy 5 weeks ahead for the guys from Lamond!
